## LIFT OFFERS ACCESS AT AWARD WINNING MOLINEUX STADIUM.

A Stannah Access Platform AVL lift forms part of the facilities for disabled people at the award winning Wolverhampton Wanderers Football Club. The club offers 149 wheelchair spaces which, along with other facilities provided for people with special needs, helped the club win the Sports Council award for best facilities for disabled users in 1994.

The Stannah lift is located in the John Ireland Stand and allows disabled people access to the executive boxes which are located up a flight of seven steps. Previously, the problem of access was overcome by porters lifting the wheelchair and passenger up the stairs. This was obviously impractical and dangerous.

A platform wheelchair stairlift was considered to offer the best solution to the needs of the club. Stannah's Access AVL lift was specified because it provided the most practical and cost-effective solution to the problem of access in the stand where there is a narrow staircase. The AVL lift is available as a free standing unit and can be installed next to a flight of stairs without restricting access for other users. This was a particularly important consideration in the stand where there is likely to be a lot of foot traffic, especially at half time and at the end of the match.
