Subject :	Introduction of latched landing control	
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In order to comply with the new machinery directive and align our Midilift SL product with the draft requirements in the proposed European std EN81-41, latched landing control will become a standard feature on all lifts manufactured after 30 August 2010.

The platform direction controls will remain constant pressure and will continue to have preference over landings.

## Notes on the operation

A landing call can only be placed when the lift is positioned at a floor level. When the lift is between floors only the carriage direction controls will initiate movement of the platform.

As with the existing constant pressure landing button, it is important that the latched landing feature is isolated during installation, service inspection and whenever the carriage cover is removed. Details on how to isolate this control are contained within the wiring manual supplied with each lift. In addition, a warning label is fitted to the carriage frame highlighting the requirement to isolate latched landing control.
