Background

The MP lift comes with a mains cut out switch, known as 'FF. It has a separate cut out switch for the UPS, known as 'QF'.

MP offered to add an additional contact, so that the mains and UPS would be isolated with just a single switch. In addition to this, MP offered to add a 'notice' advising 'FF' is an isolation switch. SLL thought these changes to be acceptable.

However, SLSL wanted a 'red rotary switch' which has the same functionality, but is more expensive.

This improvement will need to be carried out against all SLL installed MP products. Any MP products taken on by the Branch through Pickering or Classic will have the existing 'FF' and 'QF' switches. Any decision to upgrade the stop switch will need to be made by the branch. Kits can be ordered through SLL.


From May 2014 MP agreed to provide the new red rotary stop switch on all new production lifts.

Actions:

- SLL will provide SLSL with the kits
- SLSL will need to fit this kit to all Stannah installed MP lifts that have been handed over. SLL will provide a list of jobs.
- SLL will add the new kit to lifts already in the field, yet to be handed over
- SLL will add or include the kit with lifts in storage




The pages following set out the new switch, wiring diagrams along with pictures of the assembly kit.



Test Results

The isolator and the additional contacts were tested and found that we need a larger rail in order to fit the additional parts (switch and contacts), all in line with the main supply contacts (see photo) and additional wiring.





Retrofit Kit

Considering the above, the retrofit kit apart from the parts sent by MP (main rotary switch - VCF2 and additional contacts - VZ11&VZ20) has two more components, a rail of 200mm and a 5 core 6mm cable (L = 400mm) for additional wiring and the wiring diagram as per following photos







Main Isolator Switch Retrofit Kit
