#### **Background**

It appears that when the MP Car DBG has been set to the DBG on the General Arrangement drawings, the tolerance between the guide face and the safety gear block is 0.6mm.

This small tolerance causes the safety gear block to rub in certain cases and provides extra noise during travel.

#### **Action**

Please set all Car DBG's 2mm greater than what has been drawn on the General Arrangement drawings.

The tolerance should be taken up using the packers supplied by MP with the lift.
