The option of latching control has been made available on a limited, restricted basis. The option is only available subject to a review of the proposed specific installation where individual approval has been granted. The option is not offered as a retrofit.

The operation of latching control is such that constant pressure of a call button is not required. Relays are used to latch in a call which will be maintained until the lift has arrived at its destination. It is only possible to latch a call if the doors are closed and the safety chain is complete.

On latching control installations, an inspection isolation switch is provided within the carriage. When this switch is activated, the landing and platform control buttons will default to constant pressure control. The inspection isolation switch must be activated during installation, service and maintenance operations and is located within the carriage at the top of the carriage component enclosure.

Midilift SL installations with latching control can be identified by labels positioned within the carriage frame and will be visible as soon as the cover has been removed. A new latching control wiring manual has been created which contains the connection details of the additional circuitry as well as safety notes and instruction.

It is recommended that training is to be undertaken prior to working on a latching control Midilift SL.
